






PLATTE COUNTY FACTS AVERAGE WAGE 2001-2018

Approach for Labor Analysis


"What would a prospective employer want to know about a **local** labor force?"

- •What are the characteristics of available workers?
- Do available workers possess needed skills or experiences to fill potential jobs?
- •Are available workers willing to commute for a new or different job?
- •What are the wage and benefit demands of available workers?
- •Will available workers travel the necessary distance to the job site – and at what wages?





Number of Calls by State






Approach to Estimate Available Labor Pool

Civilian Labor Force + discouraged workers + homemakers + students + military + retired

- those that indicate they are <u>not</u> available for a job or new job
 - = Available Labor Pool






The Available Labor Pool is composed of workers categorized as either 1) currently not employed and looking for employment, 2) currently not employed *but* interstested in employment, 3) currently employed *and* looking for employment, 4) currently employed *but* interested in other employment for the *right opportunities*.










Available Labor Pool's Willingness to Commute






Wage Expectations Among Available Labor Pool






Desired Benefits of Available Labor Pool






Wage Expectations Among those Within Necessary Commute Time

Light Industry Subset




Within Necessary Commute Time - Desired Hourly Wage












Considerations for Employment Light Industry Subset




