

### Education

The Platte County EDC . . . . .

1. supports legislation that mandates standards, accreditation, accountability and transparency criteria for all publicly funded schools.
2. supports local control of publicly elected school boards (i.e. employee compensation, class size, curriculum, school calendar etc).
3. supports fully funding the Foundation Formula, and prioritize the closure of the current transportation shortfall.
4. supports school districts to develop career pathways, internships, and apprenticeships aligned to local workforce needs, including dedicated funding for career and technical center cooperatives and innovation centers.
5. will continue to monitor movement toward a pre-K funding mechanism.

### Transportation

The Platte County EDC . . . . .

1. supports efforts to resolve Missouri's crisis in transportation infrastructure. Supports new and innovative ways to fund all modes of transportation throughout the state and region. This includes upgrade of roads, highways, waterways, rail, public transit and air travel in efficient and cost-effective manner.
2. supports funding for the Buck O'Neil Bridge.
3. will continue to monitor equity of GO Bonds.
4. will continue to advocate for PIAC.
5. will continue to advocate for improved transit including access to jobs.
6. will continue to monitor efforts of motor fuel tax within each MODOT district.

### Economic Development

The Platte County EDC . . . . .

1. supports fully funding the Missouri Partnership which serves as a critical partner in our business attraction efforts.
2. supports updating Missouri's tax system in order for the state to fully compete for business.
3. supports tax credits for key economic development initiatives.
4. supports the effort to retain Fort Leavenworth as the brain center of U.S. armed services.
5. supports legislation which allows Community Improvement Districts to cover more than one jurisdiction i.e. Platte & Clay Counties, Kansas City & other Platte County communities.
6. supports our state association, MEDC, in its high priority item for a training hybrid to expand and fund the workforce training model which would enhance Missouri's incentive offering for new and expanding businesses.
7. supports legislation for the Talent Retention Act, which would require employers to provide notification of mass layoffs.
8. supports legislation for the creation, operation and maintenance of a metropolitan park and recreation district.
9. will continue to monitor municipalities' efforts regarding affordable housing, the boarder war and incentives.
10. will continue to monitor reform movement on tax increment financing.
11. supports a capitalization rate on the valuation of property and for a longer time period for appeals.

### Federal Legislation
